## SUMMARY

### New Software:

- Mark Barkenbush explained, with examples, the new software being used to track helicopter flights arriving and departing.
- Software has ability to record tail numbers, neighborhood reports, company, etc.
  - Note- request to redact the names and numbers of reporting neighbors BUT retain the notation of the neighborhood for the report.
  - Note – Also suggested use of “Undetermined” in cases where software reports a “gap” in the radar tracking.
- Goal of software use is to provide record of flights and follow up with those which are non-compliant to the “Fly Friendly” zone. Those flights can now be accurately documented and the companies can be alerted to repeat offenders. Banner would do so with written notice to the companies.
- Software has not been completely vetted. It requires a great deal of time and Mark will be asking for assistance from staff. It should be running shortly with data informing Banner of repeat non-compliant aircraft so letters can be sent to companies.

### Neighbor Reports to Banner

It was requested that there be two ways to report:

- 1 - the traditional telephone call to the Banner Security reporting number
- 2- an electronic option – which Banner will research
